## AMAPCO By-law 2: Chapter Boundary Changes, Meetings and Elections\*

Originally adopted October 8, 1990  
Incorporating amendments adopted through September 18, 2013

### Part A - Introduction

1. The purpose of this by-law is to amend the boundaries and names of a number of AMAPCO Chapters, under the authority of Articles 11 and 12 of the Association's Constitution.

### Part B - Mergers and Impact on Chapter Meeting and Election Requirements

2. The Ministry of Transportation Chapter and Ministry of Transportation employees in the Hamilton St. Catherine Chapter will be merged into a single Ministry of Transportation Chapter, and all employees in other ministries in the Hamilton St. Catherine Chapter will be re-assigned into their relevant ministry Chapters. This by-law of the relevant Chapters will be revised to require that multi-site Chapter meetings will be held and that Chapter elections will be conducted by mail ballot.

### Part C - Joint Ministry-Regional Chapters, Meetings and Representation

3. For all joint ministry-regional Chapters, the Chapter by-law shall make provision for (a) the ability of ministry employees to meet separately to discuss ministry-specific issues (notwithstanding the requirement for a minimum number of Chapter meetings); (b) the right of ministry employees to electively nominate AMERC representatives; and (c) representation from the ministry to be specified on the Chapter executive committee; (d) representation from other ministries in the region to be specified on the Chapter executive committee.

### Part D - Disestablishment of Chapters and Impact on Chapter Meeting and Election Requirements

4. On a date to be determined by the Annual Delegates' Conference through an amendment to the Constitution, the North York Chapter will be disestablished, and in the meantime, members will be assigned to the ministry Chapters of the ministries in which they are employed. The by-laws of the receiving ministry Chapters will be amended by the Board to require that multi-site Chapter meetings be held and that Chapter elections will be conducted by mail ballot.

\* On June 15, 2002, the Delegates authorized the Board of Directors to delete a number of related references in the Constitution and By-laws, including the listing in this by-law of various Chapter mergers, disestablishments and boundary changes that have been approved since 1990. The Board approved the deletions on August 15, 2002, with the proviso that the references be retained in an Archive of Transitional Amendments and Chapter Boundary Changes. The Delegates also specified that the by-law shall state the references to joint ministry-regional Chapters (in Part C) and to the requirement for multi-site Chapter meetings and mail ballots for Chapter elections (Part B and D).
