Bodywork and fittings 11\*17

**Steering column shrouds**  
4 Fully extend the steering column, then remove the steering wheel as described in Chapter 10.  
5 Undo the 2 retaining screws and unclip the shrouds (see Illustration).  
6 Refitting is a reversal of removal.

**Driver's side switch panel**  
7 Disconnect the battery (negative lead as described in Chapter 8).  
8 Starting at the top, using a blunt, flat-bladed tool, carefully pry the switch panel downwards (see Illustration). Disconnect the wiring plug on the panel in situ.  
9 Refitting is a reversal of removal.

**Complete fascia assembly**  
10 Disconnect the battery (negative lead as described in Chapter 8).  
11 Remove the steering column combination switch as described in Chapter 10.  
12 Unclip the immobiliser antenna from the ignition lock, and disconnect the wiring plug (see Illustration).  
13 Note their fitted positions and harness routing; then disconnect any wiring plugs from the steering column.  
14 Remove the instrument cluster, instrument information display unit (where fitted), fascia-mounted speakers and fascia-mounted audio unit as described in Chapter 10. On models without an information display unit, undo the four screws above the radio control trim plate (see Illustration).  
15 Use the retaining screws and panel retainers to hold the radio mounting bracket (see Illustration).

25.14 Press the panel from above the radio location.

25.15a Undo the screw (arrowed), release the clips ...

25.15b Undo the screw (arrowed), release the clips ... and pull the support bracket from the fascia.

25.17a Undo the nuts (arrowed) and pull the gearchange lever assembly from the radio mounting bracket (see Illustration).

25.17b Pull the earth connection (arrowed) from the mounting stud.

25.18 Press the top edge of the driver's switch panel rearwards.

25.19 Undo the driver's side switch panel and centre console as described in this chapter.

25.17c Undo the 3 retaining nuts, and detach the gearchange lever assembly from the support bracket and move it to one side (see Illustration).

25.12 Lift the clip (arrowed) and slide the immobiliser antenna from the switch panel.

25.16 Remove the earth connector from the mounting stud.

25.18 Remove the heating ventilation control panel as described in Chapter 5.

25.19 Unclip the upper storage unit from the fascia (see Illustration).

25.19 Undo the upper storage unit
